THE FOLLOWING REPRESENTS THE ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE ANGLETON SENIOR CITIZEN COMMISSION IN THE ORDER THEY OCCURRED DURING THE MEETING. THE SENIOR CITIZEN COMMISSION OF ANGLETON, TEXAS CONVENED IN A REGULAR MEETING ON MONDAY, JULY 6, 2020, AT 11:30 A.M. IN ROOM ONE OF THE ANGLETON RECREATION CENTER, 1601 N VALDERAS, ANGLETON, TEXAS.

- 1. Declaration of a quorum and call to order.
With a quorum present, Pat Aschenbeck, Senior Coordinator, called the Senior Citizen Commission meeting to order at 11:30 A.M.**
- 2. Citizens wishing to address the Senior Citizen Commission.
No citizens were present to address the commission.**
- 3. Approve the minutes of the meeting called on Monday, July6, 2020.
Upon a motion by Senior Commission Member, Archie Milam, and seconded by Senior Commission Meeting, Judy Shaefer, Angleton Senior Citizen Commission approved the minutes of regular called meeting of June 1, 2020. The motion passed on a 3-0 vote.**
- 4. Discussion on updated Recreation Center Guidelines.
Pat Aschenbeck, Senior Coordinator, talked about the updated reopening guidelines, pool capacity availability, and the need to make reservation ahead of time. Also discussed were the new mask order for anyone over 10 years or older coming in the recreation center; the only exception being if an individual is swimming or has a doctor's note.**
- 5. Discussion regarding ActionS activities at the Recreation Center.
Pat Aschenbeck, Senior Coordinator, spoke to Colleen, with ActionS, regarding donations. Donations are coming in but not a lot; Colleen was uncertain if any monetary donations were received. Judy Shaefer, Senior Commission Member, spoke about submitting information to The Facts regarding ActionS donations and it was**

published. Roger Collins, Senior Commission Member, also, put a blub in his church's newsletter soliciting donations for ActionS.

6. Discussion on the new for the senior newsletter.
Pat Aschenbeck, Senior Coordinator, discussed the newsletter and talked about all the activities.
7. Discussion on the virtual classes and program for the seniors.
New activities include a Virtual Book Club starting Tuesday. The book she will be introducing is "The Keeper of Lost Things". A Senior Social will also be held virtually in addition to the Senior Birthday Party.
8. Discussion on the senior birthday party.
Pat Aschenbeck, Senior Coordinator, discussed the outline of the party, informed commission members there were 22 currently registered and we accept up to 100. Pat, also, discussed getting Gypsy Signs to create banners advertising the event so it is visible from the street. Archie Milam, Senior Commission Member, inquired about the box lunch and Pat informed the group it would consist of a subway boxed lunch with a sandwich, chips, and a cookie. Bottled water will be handed out as well with goodie bags.

RESOLUTION 2007-R-3A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A SENIOR CITIZENS COMMISSION, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO APPOINT MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION TO REPORT BACK TO THE CITY COUNCIL ON MATTERS OF IMPORTANCE TO SENIOR CITIZENS OF ANGLETON, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas (the "City") desires to create a senior citizens commission to communicate the needs and issues of seniors living in Angleton, Texas to the Mayor and City Council. This shall be accomplished by educating, advising, and making recommendations in the areas of, including but not limited to, housing, transportation, health care, legislative, recreation, and other quality-of-life issues; and

WHEREAS, The City of Angleton has a growing population of senior citizens, and

WHEREAS, Citizens over the age of 55 account of 17.95 per cent of the population of Angleton; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Angleton recognizes the special needs of senior citizens; there for

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON;

Section 1. They shall approve the creation of a Senior Citizens Commission.

Section 2. The Commission shall elect their own officers and chairperson.

Section 3. The Commission shall report to the City Council recommendations that are concern to Senior Citizens.

Section 4. The Commission shall hold public meetings.

Section 5. The Commission shall advise the council on issues of housing, transportation, health care, legislative, recreation and other quality of life issues.

Section 3. All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section or other part of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall ever be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this resolution and the application of such word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or other part of this resolution to any other person or circumstance shall not be affected thereby.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON:


SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 2007-R-3A, be amended to add the provision that the City Council shall appoint the members of the Senior Citizen Commission.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.





Birthday Drive-Thru Update – Staff got quotes for food and the seniors received a subway box lunch when they drove through our rec center driveway. Staff and volunteers passed out 59 lunches, and we coordinated with ActionS to have 8 of those 59 lunches delivered to them. Along with the lunch they received a goodie bag. Then there was a Zoom celebration and staff gave away 11 door prizes.

Christmas Drive-Thru Update – Staff has been getting quotes for serving the seniors a hot traditional Christmas meal. Just like the Birthday Drive-Thru, the Christmas Celebration will include a lunch and a goodie bag that will include information on our Zoom Celebration for the seniors to join in with us. Staff is also coordinating with ActionS to get the meals delivered to seniors who are not able to drive. We are anticipating to have 10 door prizes to give away during our Zoom Celebration.

Virtual Classes Update – Staff will discuss the virtual classes and ask if anyone has any ideas on any classes that can be done virtually.

ActionS Update – Staff will discuss the progress that ActionS has with the delivery of food for the seniors. ActionS is still in need of donations. ActionS just started a Senior Chat Line and they call people to check on them and if anyone needs to just talk you can call them.
