On April 10, 2022, at approximately 0200 hours, Angleton Police Department was notified by the Lake Jackson Police Department that an Angleton Police Officer was involved in a physical altercation at a residence in the 200 block of Azalea Street, Lake Jackson, Texas, while off duty. This incident involved Corporal Chapa, employed as a police officer with the Angleton Police Department.

On April 10, 2022, at approximately 1600 hours, Corporal Chapa was notified that she was under administrative investigation and was placed on administrative leave pending the outcome of the investigation that the Lake Jackson Police Department was conducting. This is standard practice for all officers involved in off duty incidents of this type.

On April 20, 2022, the case was submitted to the Grand Jury and reviewed by the Brazoria County District Attorney's Office. No action was taken against any party involved. An Angleton Police Department internal administrative investigation was completed, and Corporal Chapa was taken off administrative leave and returned to duty.

We will continue being transparent with our citizens and community and hold our employees accountable for all actions. Finally, we will continue providing excellent service.
