



## Emergency Document List

Store copies of essential documents in a waterproof, fire-resistant container and keep secure digital copies backed up online or on a password-protected flash drive. Keeping one physical copy and one digital copy stored securely ensures that you will have easy access to this information in all types of emergencies. Make sure trusted family members know where these documents are located.

### Important documents to include:

- Government-issued photo IDs (driver's license, passport)
- Birth certificates and Social Security cards
- Insurance policies (home, flood, auto, health)
- Medical information (prescriptions, allergies, medical conditions)
- Health insurance cards and provider contact information
- Property records or lease/rental agreements
- Vehicle titles and registration
- Banking and financial account information
- Emergency contact list (family, doctors, caregivers)
- Pet records (vaccination records, microchip info, vet contacts)
- Utility account numbers and important service contacts
